Our Programs

Financial Exploitation Prevention Center & Financial Literacy Program (FEPC)

The FEPC is a groundbreaking partnership that unites GSI and more than a dozen social service agencies and the Tarrant County District Attorney's office to fight fraud and financial exploitation of older and other vulnerable adults. Services range from bilingual financial literacy training to public and social services that help Tarrant County residents rebound from financial exploitation and hold wrongdoers accountable.





Money Management: the least restrictive alternative

Money Management services offer alternatives to guardianship ranging from budgeting and financial coaching to representative payee services for adults who receive most of their income from public benefits.


Guardianship Program

Guardianship is a last resort for at-risk individuals referred by county probate courts, often because the client has lost their primary caregiver, suffered abuse, neglect or exploitation, and is unable to care for themselves or manage legal, financial or medical decisions.


